<u>After Treatment</u> <u>Pest Control</u>

All residents must plan to be out of the house for a minimum of 2 hours. Household pets must plan to stay out of the house for 4 hours. Birds need 24 hours.

Maintain a clean and sanitary home environment.

This involves vacuuming and regular housekeeping especially the kitchen.

Remove and clean food scrapes that may provide a source of food for cockroaches. It is very important to regularly clean stoves cooking surfaces, between cabinets and appliances, under refrigerators and inside cabinets.

Removing and eliminating water that cockroaches need for survival. This is a particularly important way to help with cockroach control.

Removing, organizing and cleaning up clutter, piles of newspaper, grocery bags, cardboard or anything else that will provide protective hiding places for cockroaches.
